Nuclear Energy	51.0%
Waterpower	25.1%
Natural Gas*	10.2%
Wind	9.9%
Solar PV	2.5%
Bioenergy	0.4%
Other (non-emitting) **	0.9%

* Includes Lennox, dual fuel (natural gas/bioenergy) and non-contracted emitting generation consistent with IESO.

** Other represents a variety of non-contracted fuel types that the IESO is unable to categorize due to a lack of information from Local Distribution Companies (LDCs).
