2021 Boundaries

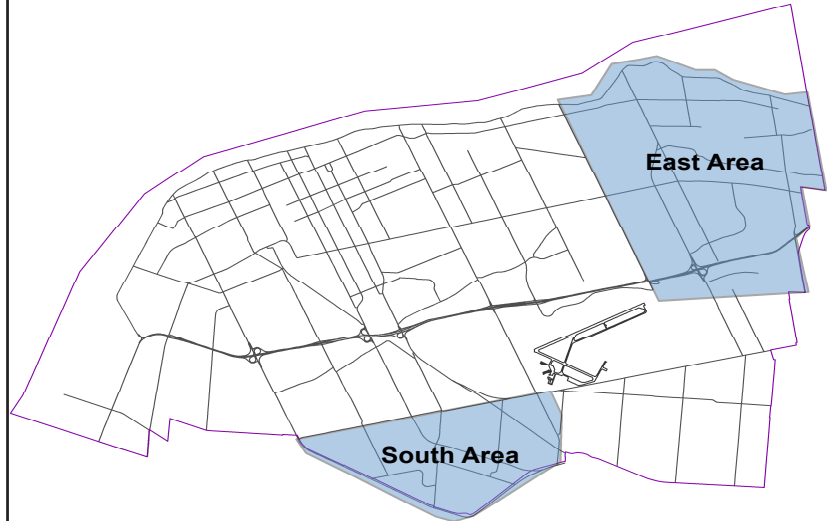
East Windsor Area:

About Hydrant Flushing

Why is Hydrant Flushing Necessary?

Hydrant flushing removes sediment from the pipes, maintains water clarity and quality, and ensures adequate supply to fight fires.

What Can I Expect?

Mild discolouration and sedimentation may occur. This is normal and water is safe. Boiling water is not necessary.

What Should I Do?

While we are in your neighbourhood, please follow these recommendations:

- Avoid doing laundry until water runs clear.
- Wait until water is clear before drinking.
- Use only cold water until flushing is complete.
- When flushing is complete in your area, run cold water through your interior faucets until clear.
- If discolouration lasts longer than 12 hours, please call ENWIN at 519-255-2727.
