(A) Service Call by Water Operations</p> <p>Where WUC's water operations department is dispatched to investigate water quality issues, leaks and other service matters on the private side of the service not attributable to WUC the following rates apply. These rates cover a basic one hour call. When extensive work is required other charges in this schedule may apply as provided for in 4 and 9 below.</p> <p>(B) Customer-Missed Service Appointment</p>	<p>Regular hours- \$80 per call After Hours - \$150 per call</p> <p>Regular hours- \$65 per call After Hours - \$150 per call</p>
<p>2. Meters</p> <p>(A) Meter Deposits Where a customer is relocating or changing the size of the meter, a \$110 deposit applies, and the customer is responsible for the work.</p> <p>(B) Disconnect /reconnection fee applicable for the above change.</p> <p>(C) Repair or replacement of lost, stolen, damaged or frozen meter</p>	<p>\$110</p> <p>\$65</p> <p>\$300 for 5/8" and 3/4" meters. Other meter sizes are charged at Cost (Material, Labour and Services)</p>

<p>4. Alterations/Repairs of Distribution Plant or System for All Customers <i>(e.g. Water main lowering/cut in tee/valve/hydrant relocation)</i></p>	<p>Cost (Material, Labour and Services)</p>
<p>5. Subdivision Development Fees and Deposits</p> <p>(A) Subdivision Administration Fee (B) Security Deposit (C) Service Inspection Fee (D) New Hydrant Testing</p>	<p>\$1,200 10% of the cost of the water works \$50 per service \$250 per hydrant</p>
<p>6. Water Sampling Requests</p> <p>(A) Bacteriological sampling (B) Lead Sampling (C) Schedule 23/ 24 Analysis (Metals, Pesticides, PCBs)</p>	<p>\$115 \$150 \$800</p>
<p>7. (A) New Watermain Disinfection</p> <p>Costs (pressure testing, chlorination etc.) associated with failure due to contractor negligence. There would be no charge for the initial work associated with a new watermain but if WUC forces are required subsequently to return to disinfect the watermain the charge will be levied.</p> <p>(B) Boil Water Advisory</p> <p>This fee will be charged <u>in addition</u> to direct costs associated with the repair of the event. This fee is intended to recover costs associated with notifications, lab tests and any other administration costs where a boiled water advisory results from work performed by an outside party. No charge will be levied if the boil water advisory is a result of inaccurate WUC locate.</p>	<p>Cost (Material, Labour and Services)</p> <p>\$750 per event</p>
<p>8. Abandonment Deposits</p>	<p>Boulevard = \$1,500 Asphalt = \$4,000 Concrete = \$6,000</p>
<p>9. Deficiency Repairs</p>	<p>Cost (Material, Labour and Services)</p>

<p>2. Inspections , Private Development (ICI Projects) on the Right-of-Way Side</p> <p>(A) Large Service Inspection (B) Small Service Inspection</p>	<p>\$250 minimum charge \$10 per metre of service pipe installed (if required) \$80</p>
