The incumbent will devise and administer inspection and preventative maintenance programs, oversee reactive repairs to malfunctioning equipment including SCADA and Distribution Automation equipment, maintenance of five 115kv Transformer Stations, Pole Top Reclosers and the correct operation of all the computerized, electronic, communication equipment. The Supervisor, Hydro Distribution/SAM will be a key consultative resource for project design and will represent a major element of the ENWIN safety program through job planning, crew briefings and the conduction of crew visits.
