ANSWERS

1. Very dangerous! You could be killed.
2. Always call to locate underground dangers before digging.
3. Very dangerous! You could be killed.
4. Stay 3 to 6 meters (10 to 20 feet) away to be safe.
5. Stay 10 meters (33 feet) away to be safe.
6. Stop. Call 911. Stay in the car and wait for help to arrive.
