It shows how electricity was generated in Ontario in 2023.

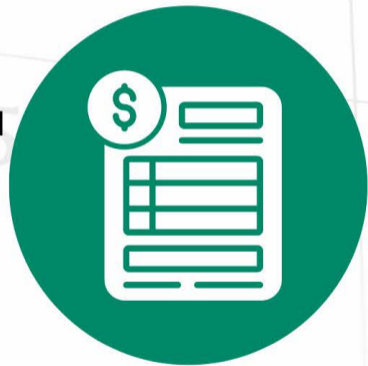
