City Identifies Pathway to Reset Stormwater Financing Plan

How this will affect your ENWIN bill:

- Eligible residential property owners will receive a rebate on their statement in 2025.
- If your June bill doesn't show a credit, it means you're already saving under the new stormwater program.
- Eligible residential property owners on septic systems will benefit from a phased-in stormwater fee.
- Qualifying places of worship and cemeteries will receive a permanent discount.
- Non-residential and multi-residential property owners will receive a one-time credit in 2025.

Who it is for	What you will receive	When you will see it on your ENWIN bill
Eligible Residents Paying More Than in 2024	A rebate based on your property's stormwater tier category and historical winter water use.	Credit for January to June on June 2025 bill. Monthly rebates July to December 2025.
Eligible Residents on Septic Systems	A 4-year phase-in of stormwater fees to provide relief to those who did not pay the sewer surcharge in 2024 and saw a large increase.	Credit for January to June on summer 2025 bill. 75% reduction in 2025. Monthly rebates July to December 2025.
Places of Worship and Cemeteries	60% exemption for properties with MPAC codes 314, 700, 701, 702, 703.	Credit January to June on summer 2025 bill. 60% exemption going forward.
Non-Residential & Multi-Residential Properties	One-time credit of \$0.12 per square metre of hard surface based on calculated impervious area.	One-time credit on summer 2025 bill.
