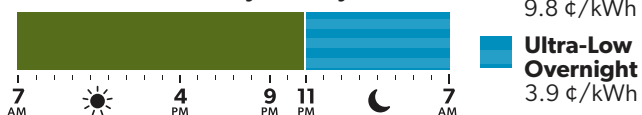


## Ultra-Low Overnight (ULO) Hours<sup>2</sup>

### Time-of-Use (TOU) and Ultra-Low Overnight (ULO)

The price for both of these plans depends on when you use electricity. On each of these plans, you can help manage your electricity costs by shifting your usage to lower price periods when possible.

### Tiered

With Tiered prices, you can use a certain amount of electricity each month at a lower price. Once you exceed that limit, a higher price applies.
